IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION FOR 2010-2011

KINDERGARTEN

For kindergarten entry, children must have a total of 4 or 5 doses of DtaP, 3 doses of HEP B, 4 doses of Polio, 2 doses of MMR, and 2 doses of Varicella (Parental documentation of chicken pox is NO LONGER acceptable).

SIXTH GRADE

All 6th graders must have one varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine. Also required is Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) vaccination.

As of July 1, 2009, proof of Tdap vaccination is required of all 6th, 7th, and 8th graders.

If your student has already received the aforementioned vaccines, please let the school office know the dates of your student's immunizations. If your student has not had these vaccines, please make an appointment with your doctor and let the school office know. **THIS MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF BEFORE SCHOOL STARTS IN THE FALL (AUGUST 31, 2010). WASHINGTON STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT CHILDREN ARE NOT TO BE IN SCHOOL WITHOUT UP-TO-DATE IMMUNIZATIONS.**
